



1880 Pickens County, Georgia Mortality Schedule

Mortality schedules for the census years 1850 through 1880 recorded the names (and other data) of persons who had died during the twelve month period preceding June 1st of the census year.

In 1880 eighteen columns appear on the schedule with the following headings: 1) Number of the family as given in the 2d column of Schedule 1; 2) Name of the person deceased; 3) age; 4) sex; 5) color: white, black mulatto, Chinese, or Indian; 6) single; 7) married; 8) widowed or divorced; 9) place of birth: naming the state, territory, or country; 10) birthplace of father; 11) birthplace of mother; 12) profession, occupation, or trade; 13) the month in which the person died; 14) disease or cause of death; 15) how long a resident of the county; 16) if the disease was not contracted at the place of death, state the place; and 17) name of attending physician.

Readers are encouraged to view the actual census record and to use it in conjunction with the 1880 U.S. Census, Population Schedule for Pickens County (T9, reels 160 and 161).

Visitors of this site are encouraged to view the actual mortality schedule on microfilm as cited below. There is more data on the census schedule than is available in the abstracts give below on this web site. The microfilm is locally available at the Pickens County Library, Jasper, Georgia; the Georgia Archives, Atlanta, Georgia; and the National Archives-Southeast Region, East Point, Georgia. The film may also be rented and viewed at one of the many local LDS branch libraries of the Family History Library in Salt Lake City.
