



Pickens County, Georgia, Families Supplied Salt by Governor Joe Brown 24 December 1863

At various intervals during the Civil War, Governor Joe Brown gave orders that salt be supplied to wives and widows of soldiers serving the Confederate cause and in some instances widows having a son or sons in Confederate service. Below you'll find a list of the **four hundred and ten** families that were supplied Salt as listed on the 24 July 1863 order given by Governor Brown. These records are categorized by situation, e.g. names of widows of deceased soldiers (77); names of wives of soldiers now in service (261); names of widows having a son or sons now in the service ((47); names of families dependent on the labor of a soldier now in service for support (10); and names of disabled discharged soldiers (15).
