The Mexican War, 1846-1848

The annexation of Texas and the westward movement of American settlers were the root of the Mexican. In 1845, President James K. Polk set the United States Boundary at the Rio Grande, but no Mexican politician would agree to the alienation of any of the Texas territory. In 13 Jan 1846, Polk directed General Zachary Taylor's army to advance to the Rio Grande. The Mexicans viewed the army's advancement as an act of war.

The United States soldiers included a number of Wood(w)ards, documented in the Index to Compiled Service Records of Volunteer Soldiers Who Served During the Mexican War [National Archives micropublication M616, reel 41].

State Registration of WW I Service: Georgia

In April 1917, the United States entered World War I. Nearly 750,000 Missouri men registered for the draft. Over 156,000 served in all branches of the armed forces and more than 10,000 were wounded or killed in action. Missouri contributed military personnel to all branches of service during the war.

The United States Congress passed an act in July 1919 providing that a record of service for each soldier, sailor, and marine who served between April 6, 1917, and November 11, 1919, be created and furnished to the adjutant general of the individual states. Clerks in the Department of the Army and the Department of the Navy created these cards; the project continued into the 1920s.

The Army/Marine service card was referred to as Form No. 724-1, A.G.O. Paragraph five of the card, printed on the reverse, states: "Except the data contained on the first four lines and that relating to battle casualties and physical disability, this statement is prepared as far as practicable from the service record, and no effort has been made to compare the data obtained from the service record with other records, except where an error or discrepancy is patent." The Navy card does not contain similar printed material.

The Georgia service cards are located at the Georgia Archives, within the records of the Adjutant General, (RG 22-1-33). These records were microfilmed January 2002. The record are arranged by Branch of service, thereunder by category and thereunder alphabetically by surname as follows:

- (1) Army – by enlisted personnel, officers and nurses and then by deceased officers and enlisted personnel.
- (2) Navy – with officers and enlisted personnel in one alphabetical sequence and then by deceased officers and enlisted personnel. The deceased category refers only to those individuals who died while in the service.

Each card contains the following information:

- (1) Full name
- (2) Service or serial number
- (3) Race (Army only)
- (4) Full address
- (5) Place of enlistment or induction
- (6) Place of birth
- (7) Age (in years and fractions of years)
- (8) Service organizations
- (9) Grades
- (10) Engagements
- (11) Wounds
- (12) Overseas service
- (13) Date of honorable discharge
- (14) Report of disability and percentage thereof, if applicable

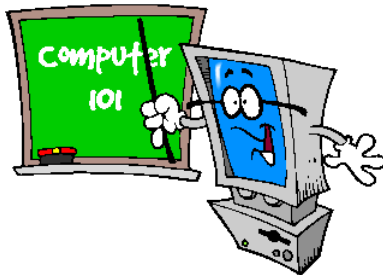
